Martha Washington

Martha was born on 02.06.1731 to John Dandridge (14.07.1700 - 31.08.1756) and Frances Jones (10.04.1710 - 09.07.1785). She was born in Chestnut Grove. She died on 22.05.1802 as 70 years old in Mount Vernon.



husband George Washington

George was born on 22.02.1732 as 1st child to parents Augustine Washington (12.11.1694 - 12.04.1743) and Mary Ball (30.11.1708 - 26.08.1789) His father died on 12.04.1743. George was 11 years old then. He died on 14.12.1799 as 67 years old in Mount Vernon. Note: acute laryngitis

Was an American statesman and soldier who served as the first President of the United States from 1789 to 1797 and was one of the Founding Fathers of the United States. He served as Commander-in-Chief of the Continental Army during the American Revolutionary War, and later presided over the 1787 convention that drafted the United States Constitution. He is popularly considered the driving force behind the nation's establishment and came to be known as the "father of the country," both during his lifetime and to this day.

He died on 08.07.1757 as 45 years old in New Kent County.
